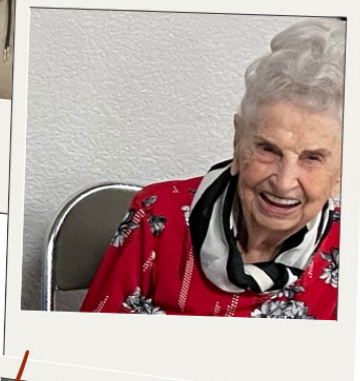
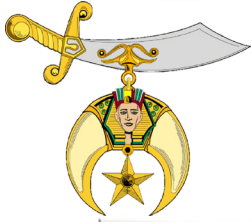

Noble Brothers of El Zaribah Shrine,

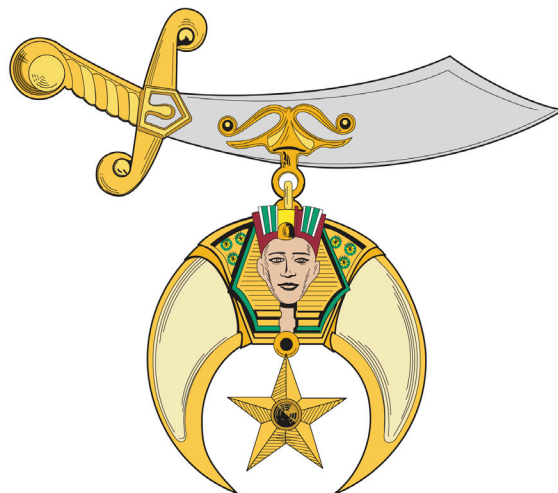

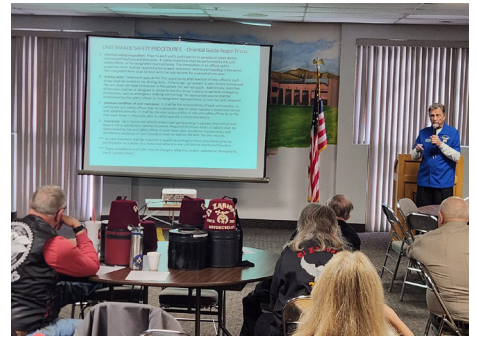


2024 - Clown Kachina

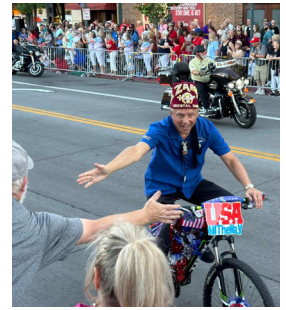

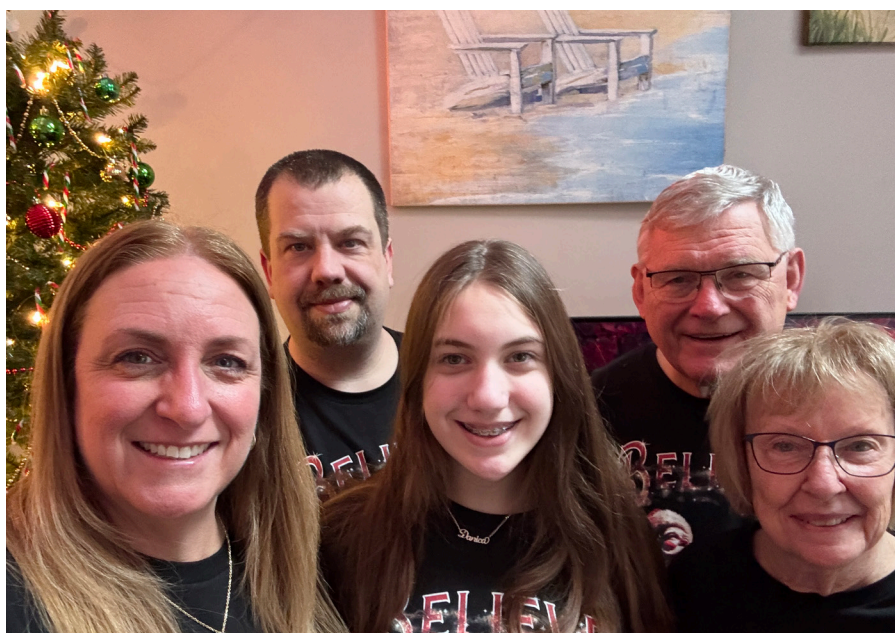
